Questioning Causality

The discussion's critical approach to evaluating whether migration per se has a causal impact on wage dynamics is commendable.

It raises an important point about the potential role of individual-level predispositions and investments in marketable skills prior to migration.

The discussion could benefit from a more detailed exploration of potential mechanisms.

For instance, it could delve deeper into the specific skills or experiences that migrants might acquire abroad that contribute to their improved outcomes upon return.

Areas of Improvement

1. Endogeneity Concerns:

The acknowledgment of potential endogeneity in the regression models is important. However, the discussion could further elaborate on the methods used to address this, such as the migrant-network instrument, and why this approach is appropriate.

2. Comparison Across Time Periods:

The differences in outcomes before and after significant events (like the Arab Spring) are mentioned but could be more explicitly analyzed. A separate subsection focusing on these temporal changes would be beneficial.

3. Policy Recommendations:

The section touches on policy implications but could offer more concrete recommendations. For instance, how can the findings inform specific policies on education, labor markets, or migration management?

4. Individual-Level Effects:

The suggestion that return migrants might be endowed with time-constant characteristics that correlate with migration decisions warrants further exploration. Identifying these characteristics more concretely could add depth to the analysis.

How does return migration influence socioeconomic mobility in Egypt?

What are the characteristics of return migrants in Egypt compared to non-migrants?

How have migration patterns and their impact on labor market outcomes changed in Egypt over the years?

What role do historical and geographic factors play in determining migration destinations for Egyptian migrants?
